FOOD 101: Intro to Critical Food Studies

This course introduces students to a broad range of topics in food studies using a critical social science approach. It focuses on the whole agri-food system from farm to fork to landfill to explore the social, political, environmental, and cultural dimensions of food. Together, we evaluate the challenges of achieving food security, social justice, and sustainability in the global agri-food system and assess the viability of different alternatives.

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
